Shopping at the Market

Learning Area: Mathematics | Grade: Grade 1 | Task Type: Worksheet | Competency: problem solving

Real Life Scenario:

Mama Jane goes to the market to buy fruits. She buys 3 apples and 2 oranges. How many fruits does she have in total?

Learning Outcomes:

- Add numbers within 10 in a real-life context
- Solve simple word problems involving addition
- Apply counting skills to find totals

Activity Steps:

Step 1: Read the story about Mama Jane's shopping.

Read aloud or to yourself: 'Mama Jane goes to the market to buy fruits. She buys 3 apples and 2 oranges. How many fruits does she have in total?'

Step 2: Count the apples and oranges using your fingers or counters.

Show 3 fingers for apples, then 2 more fingers for oranges. Count all fingers together: 1, 2, 3, 4, 5.

Step 3: Write the addition sentence.

Write: $3 + 2 = ?$

Step 4: Find the total and write the answer.

Count again if needed. Write the answer: 5 fruits.

Step 5: Draw a picture to show your answer.

Draw 3 apples and 2 oranges. Circle all fruits to show the total.
